## Eligibility:

- Undergraduate junior/senior or graduate student enrolled at Eckerd College, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Florida Atlantic University (Harbor Branch campus), Florida Polytechnic, Florida Southern, Florida Tech, Rollins College, Seminole State College of FL, Southeastern University, Stetson, University of Central Florida, University of Florida or University of South Florida.
- Any major or minor with the intention of pursuing a career in the environmental field.
- Undergraduate juniors/seniors and graduate students must be in good or non-probationary standing.

## Requirements:

- A 500-word-maximum essay detailing your plausible solution or projected/successful implementation
  of a project or program to either pre-empt or solve a Florida environmental issue. Your essay will be
  judged on Originality, Presentation (professional assemblage suitable for publication), and Written
  Communication (grammar and clarity). A word count (not including references) must be included at
  the end of the document.
- A 200-word-maximum career objective describing your involvement in the environmental field through extra-curricular activities and explaining why you are dedicated to environmental stewardship and pursuing a career in the environmental field. A word count must be included at the end of the document.
- Submit completed application package consisting of your essay and career objective in pdf format, transcript(s) and a collegiate academic or professional reference that supports your career objective by the submittal deadline.
- Attend a METRA monthly meeting shortly after notification to present essay and receive funds.
