Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Petroleum - Pervious

- 25 gallons or more
- File Discharge Report Form (DRF)
- Within 24 hours

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Petroleum - Pervious

- Less than 25 gallons
- Clean it up
- No reporting
- Subject to Rule "de minimis" provisions

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Petroleum - Impervious

- More than 100 gallons
- File DRF
- Within 24 hours

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Petroleum – Surface Water

- Any discharge amount
- Report to:
 - National Response Center (NRC) immediately
 - State Watch Office within 24 hours

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Chemical Spills – To Any Media

- CERCLA regulated
- SARA regulated
- Requires evacuation
- Report to:
 - National Response Center (NRC) immediately
 - State Watch Office within 24 hours

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Weather Related Incidents

- Due to wind, tornadoes, lightning strikes, flooding, etc.
- Damage to property or persons
- Report to State Watch Office within 24 hours

Reporting Hazardous Materials Releases Transportation Related

Report the following Incidents involving:

- Major thoroughfare closures
- Aircraft
- Railroad
- Mass casualties
- Major incidents involving commercial vehicles/vessels





Reporting Releases Domestic Wastewater

- **Call District Office:**
- Untreated < 1000 gallons
- **Call State Watch Office:**
- Untreated > 1000 gallons
- Unauthorized discharge of Public Access Reuse > 1000 gallons





Reporting Releases Failure to Report?

- Failed to report, but cleaned up spill – Call FDEP district office
- Deliberately discharged – Call 911
